






### A MAP OF THE DIOCESE



#### The 7 Parishes






## ABOUT THE DIOCESE

We are a small church - 6877 Catholics in a population of 109,991. Served by eight priests on five islands.

#### WE HAVE TWO LARGE CAPITAL PROJECTS.

St. Mary's school was built for 200 students and now has 600 students. We purchased a piece of land for \$518,000 and plan to renovate the school at an estimated cost of \$1.5 million.

St. Martin's School is a well respected boys school. It has purchased 15,000 sq.ft. of land adjacent to the school at the cost of US\$185,998.06 to build an auditorium which will serve the 4 Catholic Schools. Presently there is no place for any of the schools to gather, perform drama or do indoor sports. The auditorium is estimated to cost US\$1,000,000.00.



We have four schools, two run by the St. Joseph of Cluny Sisters and two by the diocese.
